

## After School Achievement Program

Socially distant activities for school-age children

- Served 5,626 meals for 58 school-age children
- 48% of after school children were participants of Sybil Smith Family Village
- In April 2021, provided 42.5 hours of academic and character-enhancing activities that include: free tutoring, a variety of crafts, STEAM (science, technology, engineering, arts and mathematics) activities and special events

## Senior Activities for Independent Living Program

Serving homebound at-risk seniors

- Tripled Dumas' manpower and vehicle deployment to carry 18,893 meals to 57 participants
- 71% of participants are nutritionally at high-risk
- Conducted 1,451 well checks for 73 area at-risk seniors
- Distributed weekly healthy lifestyle packets regarding nutrition, exercise and COVID-19 information

## Sybil Smith Family Village

Transitional housing for homeless families

- Accepted 111 individuals into Sybil Smith
- Provided 14,995 bed nights for 111 homeless individuals
- Conducted 1,277 case management sessions and provided 80 virtual life skills classes
- 85 individuals successfully moved into permanent housing
