

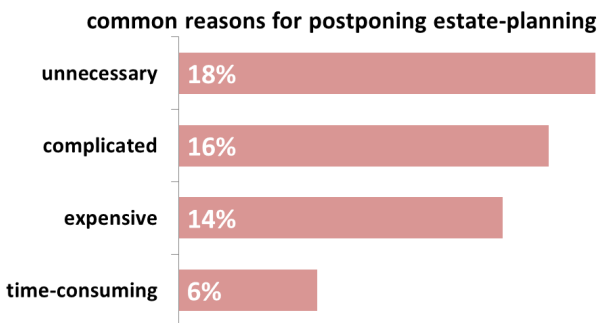

the benefits

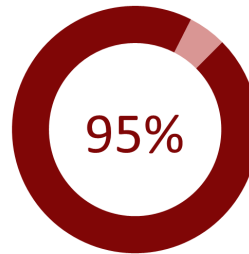

In the absence of a will, state law will distribute your property through an inflexible formula known as interstate succession. 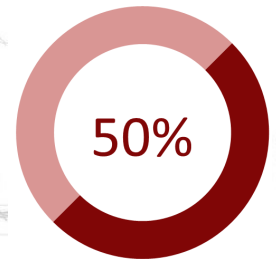

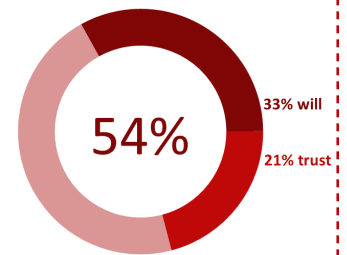
Americans who want their property transferred to the person of their choice
