Job summary

Summary of essential job functions

Staff must be able to work well with children of all ages, have strong communication skills and be able to lead by example as a positive role model. Staff will be following a planned curriculum approved by the Summer Recreation directors.

Minimum requirements

Must be an incoming high school senior and/or 18+, ability to work well with others, strong communications skills, self starter, energetic.

Abilities required

Physically fit, not afraid of the water, able to think quickly and react quickly to certain situations and emergencies.
